Self-reporting and PSI

Self-reporting deadlines varies by Institution. Self-reporting dates affect acceptance offers. Some examples:

UBC: Self-report by March 20.

Conditional offers made March 15-May 1.

SFU: Self-report by April 30th, acceptance offers by mid-May

***SFU:** Beedie School of Business applicants should have reported by March 15th.

****Note:** **UFV applicants** do not need to self-report. The PSI selection is sufficient.

One more time.... PSI

If you have not already done this.....**This is a MUST for all Universities!!**

Complete your PSI selection by **April 30th**. Students must check in on this website to authorize the Ministry to release your marks.

Accept an offer of admission?

Most universities require a deposit and have a deadline for accepting an offer.

A deposit is often non-refundable so make sure if you change your mind that you officially withdraw to avoid paying full tuition.
